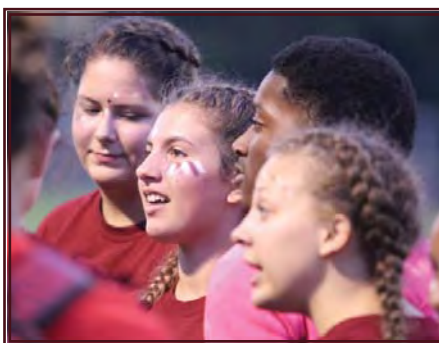
Festival of Trees
